Dear Parents / Carers

As part of our autumn work, Year 6 will be answering the question ‘What Does it Mean to be Powerful?’ and exploring the themes of democracy, responsibility and wealth. To further enhance their learning, I am taking the class to London to visit both Westminster Abbey and The Houses of Parliament on **Wednesday 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2024**. We will be participating workshops during the day: learning about pilgrimage at Westminster Abbey and ‘The Story of Parliament’ at The Houses of Parliament. We will also be given a guided tour of both historical buildings during our visit.

**The cost of this trip will be £10.75 and will be payable via the School Gateway App.**

The children will need to be **dropped off from 8:30am at the designated drop off point at Peterborough Station**. This is to the left of the station and clearly signposted. Unfortunately, if children are late, we will not be able to wait for them as we are catching the 8:57am Thameslink departure to London. The children will need to bring a packed lunch, drinks and snacks for the whole day. Please ensure they have enough water to last them the day just in case water fountains/refill points are busy or out of order. They must wear their school uniforms, but can wear comfortable practical shoes, such as trainers. In addition, they need to bring a waterproof coat and have a practical bag that is easy for them to carry on their body.

**At the end of the day, your child will need to be collected on foot from Peterborough Train Station at 5:40pm. Please ensure that you let us know if it will be someone other than yourself collecting your child by letting either myself or Mrs Darby in the office know.**

The children will be briefed on procedures for the day in order to ensure their safety and wellbeing.

We are all looking forward to a wonderful day out, but please do not hesitate to contact me if you have any queries regarding any aspects of the trip.
